**A**

Attendance. School starts each day at 9:00. We do lots of work each day and missing just a day can make it harder to keep up!

**C**

Communication. It is key. If you need anything or if your child says something that I need to know please call or email!

**E**

Email. Please email me whenever you need. I can usually reply faster than by the phone. I will also need your email.

**G**

Great behavior. I expect great behavior all the time. There are rewards - notes, praise, treasures, and treats.

**I**

Independence. Your student can do a lot more than you think. Look for times to allow them to do the work.

**K**

Keeping Updated. Please check for a weekly Newsletter from me with all the important updates.

**B**

Breakfast. We eat breakfast in the classroom. Breakfast starts at 8:30.

**D**

Dismissal. Will be crazy the first few days of school. If you change your dismissal way, please let the office know (and they will let me know) by 3pm!

**F**

Folder. Your child will have a daily folder. Please initial it daily and remove anything from it that needs to stay home.

**H**

Homework. Homework will go home Monday and will be due on Fridays.

**J**

Journal. We will keep a writing journal and a guided reading journal throughout the year.

**L**

Lunch. We eat lunch at 11:10am. Lunch costs \$2.25. You can pay online via [MySchoolBucks.com](http://MySchoolBucks.com) or send the money in a labeled envelope or baggie. There is no fridge for home lunches. We cannot warm up food either.

**M**

Morning. I will be outside my room each morning. You may walk your student to the classroom for several days. After that, they will need to be able to walk to room independently.

**O**

Open-Door Policy. Please speak up if there is something you need to discuss. We can set up a conference to meet so we do not take away from instructional time.

**Q**

Questions - Please question your child each day after school. Ask what they learned, who they played with, and what they ate.

**S**

Specials. We go to music, art, PE, Stem, and Technology. We will go from 12:55-1:40 each day. We will also go to the Library once a week.

**U**

Unfinished Work. We may have some throughout the year. If so, it may be sent home to finish and to be returned.

**W**

Water. We have a water fountain in our classroom that will be accessible throughout the day.

**Y**

Your help. Please check the folder each day, do homework, read each night, and clean out their backpacks daily!

**N**

News. If your child has any important news please share it with me. Not only will this help with learning but it will help me to connect with your children as people.

**P**

Patience. Please be patient the first few weeks of school. Training Kindergarten kids to get to and from school is tricky.

**R**

Remind. Please sign up on Remind to receive texts from me. This will be a great way to share news, important dates, and even pictures. Let's get 100% signed up!

**T**

Teacher. That's me! I am Nancy. This is my 10<sup>th</sup> year teaching, 8 years in Kindergarten. I have a masters in Reading and Literacy.

**V**

Volunteer. We love them! Please see the front office on how you can volunteer in the classrooms.

eXperience. Kids come to school with all sorts of them. Some can read, some have never be away from family. Please don't worry about if your child is behind or ahead at this point.
